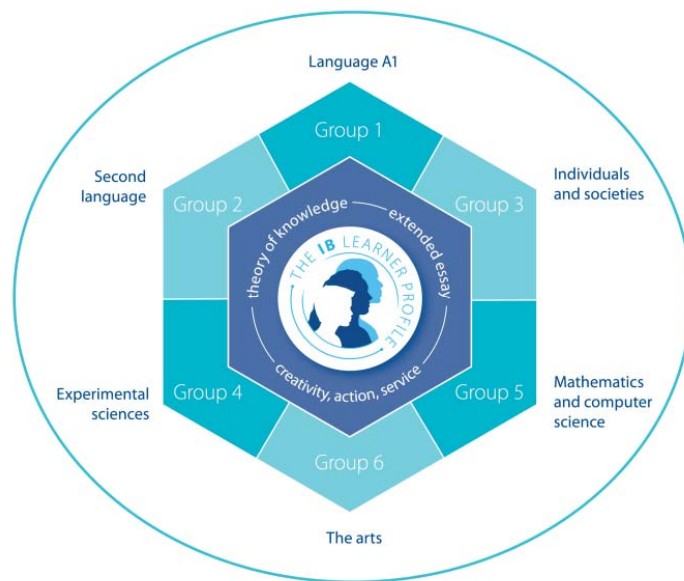


International Baccalaureate Diploma Programme

The International Baccalaureate (IB) Diploma Programme, offered at Millard North High School, is a rigorous pre-university course of study, leading to examinations, that meets the needs of the highly motivated secondary school student between the ages of 16 and 19 years or in grades 11 and 12. Designed as a comprehensive curriculum that allows its graduates to fulfill requirements of the various national systems of education, the IB is based on the pattern of no single country but incorporates the best elements of several.
