If you are interested in applying, please complete the **on-line application** by <u>March 18, 2022</u>. The salary per hour for summer school will be a current employee's normal hourly rate. A new employee hired as a paraprofessional specifically for summer school will be paid \$12.41 per hour. A new employee hired specifically for summer school as a secretary or hall monitor will be paid \$14.14 per hour.

Preference will be given to those who are currently working in the buildings that will have a summer school program along with past experience as a paraprofessional during summer school.
