Committee Meeting Minutes September 12, 2011

The members of the Board of Education met as a committee of the whole on Monday, September 12, 2011 at 6:00 p.m. at the Don Stroh Administration Center, 5606 South 147<sup>th</sup> Street. The agenda topics included school day, calendar and early dismissal.

Present: Linda Poole, Dave Anderson, Mike Pate, Patrick Ricketts, and Todd Clarke

Absent: Mike Kennedy

Also in attendance were Keith Lutz, Mark Feldhausen, Angelo Passarelli, and other administrators.

To begin the meeting Angelo Passarelli reviewed the comparisons of calendars from the other metro districts.

Mark Feldhausen presented the instructional hour comparisons from those same districts. Dr. Feldhausen gave an overview of how the buildings used the extra time in the elementary classrooms and at the middle school level. Dave Anderson would like to hear from the staff members at the end of the year as to how they thought the extra time in the classroom benefited the students. Dr. Feldhausen said a follow-up could be done at the end of the school year as to what was accomplished with those additional minutes knowing that each building uses the time to accomplish what is needed from their building plans, or how the test results of the ELOs dictates what is needed by their students.

The Board members discussed the importance of reconvening the calendar committee to receive feedback and suggestions from community members as it relates to the calendar. After the committee comes to consensus on the calendar they would provide their recommendation to the Dr. Lutz, and he would bring his recommendation to the Board of Education for approval.

In addition to the previous two parameters, which includes, each semester will have a balanced number of days with first semester ending at the winter break, and four placeholder days will be noted at the end of the calendar and will be used for the first four snow days that are taken, the board established a third parameter, which is to have the last day of school before Memorial Day. Any recommendation would affect the calendar for 2012-2013.

Dr. Lutz explained a little bit of the history as to how the early dismissal on Wednesdays began, and how the process was difficult, and consensus was not reached by the committee. Board members discussed possibly surveying the community as to their feelings about the dismissal on Wednesdays, and give them other alternatives. Dr. Lutz said an evaluation could be done if the board desires, and then he could bring a recommendation forward on early dismissal on Wednesday. Building Principals are to check with their community regarding support for Wednesday early dismissal.
