Notice of this meeting was given to all members of the Board of Education and a copy of their Acknowledgment of Receipt of Notice and the agenda are attached to these minutes. Availability of the agenda was communicated in advance notice and in the notice of the Board of Education of this meeting. All proceedings hereafter shown were taken while the convened meeting was open to the attendance of the public.

At 6:00 p.m. Dave Anderson called the meeting to order and announced the Public Meeting Act is posted on the wall and available for public inspection. Mr. Anderson asked everyone to say the Pledge of Allegiance

Roll call was taken and members present were Dave Anderson, Linda Poole, Mike Pate, Patrick Ricketts and Todd Clarke. Mike Kennedy was absent.

Linda Poole summarized the Committee of the Whole Meeting on Monday, June 11, 2012. The topics for that meeting were Truancy and Attendance, and Budget Projections

Superintendent's Comments:

- 1. Last week the Douglas and Sarpy County Superintendents met with the Governor and Commissioner for a couple of hours talking about P16 achievement gaps and state test scores. The Governor will be in our school district on August 23. He called and asked if he and Senator Adams and Commissioner Breed could meet with Dr. Lutz and anyone else that wishes to be in the room to discuss our school district and how we get the results that we get. The meeting will last about an hour and a half.
- 2. The Strategic Planning committee will meet on August 6 and 7. There will be a Board meeting that night, August 6, if necessary. It could be a short meeting to take care of a few necessary items.
- 3. The Budget Hearing timelines are being worked on. MPS tries to stay on the same time line with other school districts. We will have another meeting before September 20, when the budgets are approved.
- 4. Millard Public School offices will be closed on July 4th 2012.

Board Comments:

Mike Pate stated that about a month ago the Learning Community met and one of the items on the agenda had to do the funding for a research project through the University of Nebraska Medical Center for about \$100,000. This meeting prompted Mr. Pate to send a letter to Senator Adams and also copies to all the State Legislators, the Governor, the MPS Board members and Dr. Lutz. This letter generated much conversation and dialog, emails, phone calls and the World Herald ran an editorial regarding the letter. Mr. Pate has heard nothing but support for the stance he took on this issue. He has heard no negative responses except for those in the Learning Community that sit on the Board. Mr. Pate says this is a research project and we should not be funding research projects. This will continue to be a topic of conversation for future Learning Community meetings.

Dave Anderson met with the Learning Community School District School Board Presidents a couple of weeks ago. This was somewhat a "Meet and Greet" to introduce all the new people that have been added to the School Boards. There was a question and answer time. A NASB representative was in attendance as a resource to help summarize this meeting and come up with creative

ideas this group could talk about that would be beneficial for everyone. A summary of what was talked about will be sent out to all the School Board members of the eleven districts.

Grantor agrees that the existing grade of the Easement Area shall not be reduced more than One foot (1') in elevation without the prior approval of the District. The Grantor understands that a single pole and appurtenances may be used to provide service to this property.

In granting this easement, it is understood that said cables shall be buried below plow depth in order to not

interfere with the ordinary cultivation of the strip.

Grantor agrees that the property covered by said easement shall not be used in any way that will impair the rights of the District hereunder. Grantor agrees not to construct or erect any building or improvements other than paving, curbing and/or landscaping on or over the Easement Area.

The Grantor covenants that he/they has/have lawful possession of said real estate, good, right and lawful authority to make such conveyance and that his/her/their heirs, executors, administrators, successors and assigns shall warrant and defend the same and will indemnify and hold harmless the District forever against the claims of all persons whomsoever in any way asserting any right, title or interest prior to or contrary to this conveyance.

The District shall have the right of ingress and egress across the Grantor's property for any purpose hereinbefore granted. Such ingress and egress shall be exercised in a reasonable manner and only when reasonably necessary.

The District shall pay the Grantor and/or lessee, as their interests may appear, for all damages to growing crops, fences or other property on said real estate which may be caused by the exercise of the hereinbefore granted rights.

This easement shall run with the land, constitutes the entire agreement between the parties, and shall be binding upon the respective grantees, licensees, lessees, successors, heirs and assigns of the parties.


