Title: Senior High Guidance Counselor

Reports to: Building Principal, Director of Pupil Services

General Summary: Counsels students on personal, social, educational, and vocational issues; consults with teachers, administrators, and parents; and assists in coordinating services for students.

Essential Functions:

- 1. Counsels students on personal, social and educational problems, referring them to the proper social agency when necessary.
- 2. Assists in the administration and interpretation of all standardized testing.
- 3. Maintains all personal and confidential records of the students assigned to him/her.
- 4. Provides academic and vocational counseling for post high school planning.
- 5. Confers with parents to help solve home/school problems.
- 6. Assists students in job placement.
- 7. Assists in the orientation of new students.
- 8. Confers with teachers to help them better understand the needs of individual students.
- 9. Confers with counselors at other levels to maintain continuity in the K-12 guidance program.
- 10. Consults with professional personnel in the community and conducts research for the purpose of evaluation and improvement of the guidance program.
- 11. Participates in the summer program of visits to homes of new families in the school district.
